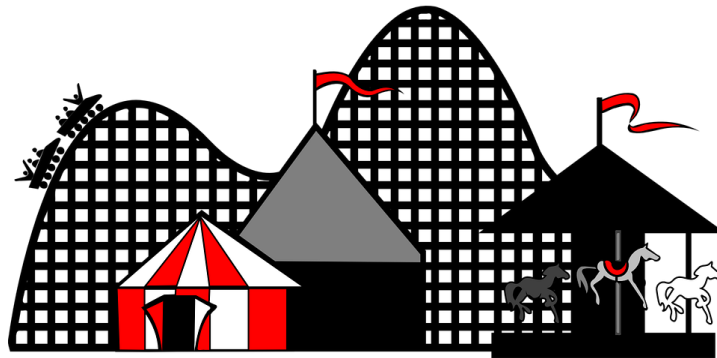


**Last Minute “6 Flags” Trip Details**  
**Friday, May 10**

1. Student arrival time is 5:00am (back of the school-by the band hall).
2. The weather could potentially be a little wet. You may want to bring an additional change of clothes and possibly a light rain coat; also bring a jacket as the bus could get cold.
3. Bring money for lunch and dinner(meals average \$15-\$20).
4. Eat or bring breakfast—NOT something greasy or heavy.
5. You may bring snacks for the bus. Drinks must be “close-able”. **You cannot bring food into Six Flags.**
6. Arrive in the morning wearing proper concert attire (blue jeans and the new **LAVENDER Trip T-Shirt**). Shirts were given out in class on Thursday.
7. Put your name and phone number (including your area code) on everything (instrument case, bags, etc.).
8. **Do not get on the buses until instructed to do so.**
9. Chaperones will load their stuff first.
10. Tuba, Euphonium, Trombone, Low Woodwinds, Trumpet, Saxophone, French Horn: place your instrument beside the bus.
11. Flute, clarinet, oboe: your instrument goes ON the bus with you.
12. Give all medications to a director.....you may NOT self-medicate.
13. Performance location is at Meyerson Symphony Center (2301 Flora Street Dallas, TX 75201)
14. Performances start with Symphonic Winds @ 10am; Honor Band performs immediately after, followed by Wind Ensemble.
15. When you assemble your instrument outside of the bus...DO NOT play outside! **We could get disqualified!** We will warm up together inside the warm up room.
16. Don't bring anything in the park that you can't carry with you all day. **You will not have access to the buses while we are at the park!**
17. When we get to Six Flags:
  - a. there will be a meeting at the buses **before** we go into the park
  - b. follow the directors into the park, listen for instructions before we enter the gates
  - c. after you enter the gate, turn left to 'Mexico'... find our signs, **wait** for further instruction
18. Be on time for the roll check—**no excuses will be accepted!!** Bring a watch, set your phone alarm, or ask park employees for the time or directions if necessary.
19. **Check in area will be in the 'Mexico' section of the park at 4:00pm.** It is on your left as you enter the main entrance.
20. CHECK IN: Find your roll check person, tell them your first and last name, watch them put a checkmark by your name!! We will show you where to meet before you are dismissed. Look for the bus roll check signs in that area. Anytime you need help or have a question, chaperones will be available in that area...they can contact a director if necessary.

21. **You may not leave the 6 Flags park areas...keep track of your group...stay together...**if you get separated, you must come to the chaperone check in area immediately! You must **NEVER** be without a Knight Band student!! If we see you alone, you will come to the chaperone area until we find your group, then you will all sit with us at the chaperone area for a minimum of 30 minutes. **SAFETY FIRST!**
22. Last check in will be on the buses. Please be at the ‘check-in’ area ready to leave by 7:30pm. We walk in groups to the buses and check in as you enter the bus.
23. We expect perfect behavior on the trip...be polite to the chaperones and follow directions the first time.
24. You must have headphones to listen to music on the bus.
25. When we return to KLMS, you will not leave the bus until the seating area is cleaned...you will be dismissed by a director or a chaperone one row at a time.
26. **Have your ride waiting at KLMS by 11:00pm.** DO NOT plan to call home for a ride after we arrive.
27. We ask that your parents not park by the curb directly in front of the band hall—the buses need to park there...

- 5:00 a.m. Meet at KLMS (back of school - by the band hall)  
\*\*(should already be wearing 2019 Spring Trip T-Shirt, Blue Jeans, shoes)
- 5:30 a.m. Depart KLMS
- 8:30 a.m. Arrive at Meyerson Symphony Center
  - Symphonic Winds performs @ 10AM. Honor/Wind follow immediately.
- 12:30 p.m. Arrive at Six Flags
- 4:00 p.m. **Check in at chaperone area**
- 7:30 p.m. **Meet at check in area/load buses (roll check on buses)**
- 8:00 p.m. Depart for Pflugerville
- 11:00 p.m. Arrive at KLMS (**PLEASE HAVE RIDE WAITING!**)

**Parents, please don't park in the fire zones so that the buses can pull in when we arrive.**

**Please have ride waiting in the back of the school, by the band hall**

## BUS SIGN-UP CRITERIA

1. Health Form/Permission Slip signed by parent/guardian
2. Clear all band accounts (fundraising, trip money, private lessons, etc.)
3. Must be academically eligible in all classes on 9-weeks 3 report card (70 or higher in all classes)
4. Groups of 4 must **ALL** be present and **ALL** meet criteria 1-3 to sign up for a bus

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### WHAT TO BRING

- Money for food at the park. **NO MEALS** are included with trip payment. Students are going to be gone for quite some time and are **NOT ALLOWED** to bring food into the park (Six Flags meals are usually \$12.00-\$15.00 each).
- Snacks to eat on the bus (drinks must have a 'twist-on' lid). No sunflower seeds or popcorn.
- School appropriate clothes for the park. We **will** be wearing the 2019 Trip T-shirt at the concert **AND** while at the park. You may also want to bring a dry change of clothes for the ride home if you plan on riding the water-type rides. It can be chilly if you are damp.
- Watch (so you can keep track of when to check in).
- Comfortable walking shoes to wear in the park...FLIP FLOPS CAN CAUSE BLISTERS.
- If you wear glasses or bring sunglasses you might want to bring a strap so you do not lose them on the rides.
- You may bring a Phone or Camera (MUST have headphones!) BUT, there is always the chance that it will be lost or stolen at the park (you may leave these items on the bus).
- Bring only what you can carry into the park. You may rent a locker if you choose to do so (sm. \$13.00, med. \$15.00, lg. \$18.00). **You will NOT have access to the buses while in the park!!**
- There will be a chaperone at the **meeting/check-in area** (Mexico by the El Sombrero ride) at all times if you need help with anything.
- You must be with your group **AT ALL TIMES!!**
- Students need to pace themselves through the day and be sure to drink lots of WATER.
- A light jacket for the evening (who knows what weather Texas will bring that weekend!).
- A good attitude.
- Students are expected to follow all appropriate band and school rules. Any student not following the rules could be asked to call their parents to come pick them up, and will not be allowed to return with the band.

### **NO DRUGS / NO ALCOHOL / NO STEALING**

We hope to go on trips like this again. Please use good, common sense.

- helping with loading and unloading of equipment
- being visible on the buses and at the festival while the students are waiting to perform
