

Last Minute “Schlitterbahn” Trip Details

1. THE PERFORMANCE VENUE HAS CHANGED.

2. We ARE performing at New Braunfels MIDDLE school.

3. GO TO New Braunfels Middle School.

4. We are NOT performing at New Braunfels High School.

5. DO NOT GO...TO NEW BRAUNFELS HIGH SCHOOL.

6. Eat a light breakfast (or bring snacks for the bus)—NOT something greasy or heavy.
7. Be on time: arrive @ KLMS by 4:30am (consider wake up calls and carpools to help each other).
8. Arrive in the morning wearing your proper concert attire (blue jeans and the PURPLE SPRING TRIP T-Shirt).
9. Put your name and phone number (including your area code) on everything (instrument case, bags, etc.).
10. Give all medications to a band director...do NOT self medicate. (If your parent is chaperoning, they may give you medication.)
11. Chaperones load their stuff first.
12. **Do not get on the buses until instructed to do so.**
13. Flute/Clarinet/Oboe will take instrument on the bus. Everyone else will place their instrument beside your bus; chaperones will load them.
14. On the bus, keep your concert clothes clean.
15. Drinks must have a 'twist-on' or 'close-able' lid -- avoid spills and messy foods.
16. Performance is between 7:45am-8:00am(warm up 7:35am) @ New Braunfels MIDDLE School-4150 Klein Meadows, New Braunfels, TX 78130.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Bring Sunscreen! (Please don't bring the spray kind.)
- Wear your trip shirt THE ENTIRE time we are at the park. Too much exposure to the sun and you will be miserable. You represent our band, school and community and we want to keep our great reputation. You will want a dry change of clothes for the way home as the buses are air conditioned and it will be chilly.
- Be on time for the roll checks—**no excuses!!** Bring a waterproof watch or ask park employees for the time or directions if necessary.

- Check in area will be in the Blastenhoff section of the park. We will show you where to meet before you are dismissed. Look for the bus roll check signs in that area. Anytime you need help or have a question, chaperones will be available...they can contact a director if necessary.
- At check-in, go to the roll check person and **tell them your name**...watch them check your name off.

- You may not leave the Schlitterbahn park areas...keep track of your group...stay together...make an emergency plan if you get separated (meet back at the 'check-in' area).
- We expect perfect behavior on the trip...be polite to the chaperones and follow directions the **first** time.
- If you plan to listen to music on the bus, you must have headphones (the music must be school appropriate).
- Students will not leave the bus when we arrive back at KLMS until the seating area is cleaned...they will be dismissed by a director or a chaperone one row at a time.
- **Have your ride waiting at KLMS by 7:30pm do NOT plan to call home for a ride after we arrive!**
- We ask that your parents not park by the curb directly in front of the band hall—that's where the buses will park...

“Check In” Instructions

The chaperone check in area is in the Blastenhoff section of the park where we will enter in the morning. Arrive early and look for the bus signs; this is the 'check-in' area. Find the sign that has the name of your bus (T-Rex, Indominus Rex, Ankylosaurus, Triceratops) **You and your group** stand in line and tell the roll check person from your bus your first and last names. Watch them check your name off. As you wait, apply more sunscreen. Drink your 'sports-type' drink after the second check-in while you wait for any final instructions. Also, take the time to eat a snack if you haven't eaten anything yet.

Lunch Instructions

You will have a wristband that entitles you to lunch (hot dogs and chips). Between 11:30am and 4:30pm, you and your group will go to the big tent in the far left corner of **Surfenburg**. They will remove your wristband and serve you.

If you want any other food or drink items, you must bring your own money to purchase them.

Itinerary:

- 4:30 a.m. Meet at KLMS (back of school - by the band hall)
**** (should already be wearing 2019 lavender trip shirt, Blue Jeans, shoes)**
- 5:00 a.m. Depart KLMS (DON'T BE LATE!)
- 6:30 a.m. arrive at New Braunfels High School
assemble instruments and prepare for warm up (DO NOT PLAY OUTSIDE OR ON THE BUS).
- 7:30 a.m. official warm up time for contest
- 8:00 a.m. official contest performance (might begin earlier, if parents would like to watch the performance, please be there by the 'warm up' time of 7:30am.)
- 9:00 a.m. load buses, distribute wristbands/towels, depart for Schlitterbahn Water Park
- 10:00 a.m. arrive at water park (Blastenhoff entrance)
- 10:15 a.m. final instructions at the "check-in/chaperone" area
- **12:30 p.m. check in #1** (reapply sunscreen, drink water, check in with bus roll person)
- **3:30 p.m. check in #2** (reapply sunscreen, drink sports/electrolyte drink, check in with bus roll person)
- **5:45 p.m. Meet at check in area/load buses (final roll check will be on the buses)**
LEAVE TIME TO CHANGE INTO DRY CLOTHES BEFORE 5:45PM!!
- 6:00 p.m. Depart for Pflugerville
- 7:45 p.m. Arrive at KLMS (PLEASE HAVE RIDE WAITING!)

Please have ride waiting in the back of the school, by the band hall—Parents, please don't park in the fire zones so that the buses can pull in when we arrive.

BUS SIGN-UP CRITERIA

1. Health Form/Permission Slip signed by parent/guardian
2. Clear all band accounts (fundraising, trip money, private lessons, etc.)
3. Must be academically eligible in all classes on 9-weeks 3 report card (70 or higher in all classes)
4. Groups of 4 must **ALL** be present and **ALL** meet criteria 1-3 to sign up for a bus

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WHAT TO BRING

- A good attitude.
- PLEASE NO PEANUTS OR ANY TREE NUTS OF ANY KIND!
- Instrument in its case with name tag, bander with all music, supplies (reeds, oils)...mouthpieces, etc.
- Snacks to eat on the bus and in the park (drinks should have a 'twist-on' lid and no glass containers).
- At least one bottle of 'Gatorade/Powerade/Electrolyte' type sports drink (we will drink this at the 2nd check-in).
- Swimwear for the park (you may wear your swimsuit under your band uniform or change at the park).
- MUST wear 2019 TRIP SHIRT while in the park.
- Towel
- SUNSCREEN- (**NO** Aerosol "Spray-On" Sunscreen Please).
- Hat (if you are sensitive to the sun).
- If you wear glasses or plan to bring sunglasses, you might want to bring a strap so you don't lose them in the water.
- Waterproof watch if you have one (students can also ask lifeguards for time periodically).
- Sandals, tennis shoes, or beach type footwear (the asphalt is hot!).
- A little extra money for souvenirs, snacks, etc. (The trip fee includes one meal – hot dogs, chips, fruit and dessert).
- Students may purchase a 'Cash Card' (money in the form of a plastic card with a lanyard or a wristband). It can be purchased in any amount. Unused money on the card/wristband can be refunded at the end of the day.
- You may bring a Phone/Camera. BUT, there is always the chance that it will be lost or stolen at the park or on the bus. Lockers are available for a fee (minimum \$12).
- Only bring what you can carry into the park. You will NOT have access to the buses while in the park!! You can keep your bag (change of clothes, towels, etc.) at the chaperone area. Lockers are available for a fee (minimum \$12).
- There will be a chaperone at the 'meeting area' (Blastenhoff) at all times if you need help with anything, BUT they can not guarantee your stuff will be untouched.
- Students need to pace themselves through the day, be sure to drink lots of WATER, and use a lot of sunscreen.
- Life jackets are available at no cost. Although the rides are well supervised and most are quite shallow, students should exercise caution concerning their abilities. Signs are posted as to the thrill level of each ride.
- Students are **NOT** allowed to leave the designated areas (**No** Dragon's Lair Hot tub, **No** tram to the Old Park, **No** Comal River).
- Students are expected to follow all appropriate band and school rules. Any student not following the rules could be asked to call their parents to come pick them up, and will not be allowed to return with the band.

NO DRUGS / NO ALCOHOL / NO STEALING

We hope to go on trips like this again. Please use good, common sense.

Chaperones will have some small duties:

- checking roll on the buses and at the designated 'check-in times' at the park
- helping with loading and unloading of equipment
- being visible on the buses and at the festival while the students are waiting to perform
- taking turns serving duty at the designated "chaperone areas"
- have fun! the rest of the time, you are free to enjoy Schlitterbahn! (Just not TOO much...no alcoholic beverages nor smoking while in the park supervising children)



Chaperones need only pay for their ticket into the park and personal expenses (food, souvenirs, etc.).
